It's easy to create a Lolly Bar with a few simple items.

You'll need a selection of glass jars, vases and/or bowls, to maximise visual impactuse containers of varying heights and different shapes. To minimize the need for gigantic vases and jars, you can add to their height by taking a small crate or box, placing it upside-down, and covering it with cloth. Bunching fabric will add depth & layers to the look as well.

The style of your containers will define the 'look', i.e. vintage apothecary or modern sleek lines are popular options. Just be sure the opening of the jar is large enough for scooping the confectionery! Choose colours and confectionery that complement your theme and décor.

Flower arrangements add a stunning touch to lolly bars. Coordinating them with the confectionery will tie lollies into the rest of the decor as well as fill up extra space on the table, eliminating the need for a large amount of containers. A variety of candles, garlands and personal items really bring the table to life and add glamour. Give your guests personalised paper bags, cups or boxes to fill with confectionery or branded for corporate events.
